* All work must be ready for installation. World of Threads Festival reserves the right to adjust or apply hanging devices for safety or security or to refuse to install a work.

* Work not received in proper condition will not be hung/installed.

* An artist statement (maximum 100 words) to be submitted by email to ixchelsuarez@gmail.com and received by Friday, 31 July, 2009.

* Insurance for artwork is the responsibility of the Artist.

* Accepted works may be offered for sale during the show at prices specified by the artist on the entry form.

* All works sold are subject to a 25% World of Threads Festival commission.

* Works not for sale should be clearly marked NFS on the entry form.

* The World of Threads Festival reserves the right to photograph works and/or use the photographs submitted for publicity, education, reference and web catalogue purposes.

* All works will remain with World of Threads Festival until the end of the exhibition.
